Advance CTE 2022 Fall Meeting Frequently Asked Questions

Who can attend Advance CTE's Fall Meeting?

While Advance CTE primarily supports state CTE leaders, all stakeholders and champions of Career Technical Education (CTE) are welcome!

What is the meeting format?

The Fall Meeting will include general sessions, smaller and interactive breakout sessions, networking opportunities, and more.

What is the registration deadline?

Early Bird registration closes at 11:59 p.m. ET on August 19, 2022. The general registration deadline is 11:59 p.m. ET on September 20, 2022.

Does Advance CTE have hotel rooms available for meeting attendees?

Yes, Advance CTE has a discounted room block at the BWI Airport Marriott. Rooms are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis, so please reserve your room early. The room block will close on September 20. The dedicated room reservation link will be available soon.

Which airport is closest to the hotel?

The Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall (BWI) Airport is a mile from the event hotel. The hotel provides a free shuttle for transport to and from the airport.

Are meals included in my registration?

Each registration includes one dinner, two breakfasts, one lunch and beverages/breaks throughout the meeting.



What coronavirus mitigation and response protocols are in place?

Advance CTE' follows the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidance, applicable state and local requirements and the following safety and mitigation protocols. Fall Meeting attendees commit to following this guidance when registering. In particular, we encourage a review of the CDC testing and masking guidance.

All non-vaccinated attendees will be required to provide a negative test result of a PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) taken no more than 72 hours prior to the beginning of the conference on October 17, 2022. Vaccinated attendees are strongly encouraged to perform a COVID-19 test prior to travel.

Advance CTE will communicate final protocols, based on current CDC and state or local requirements and in consideration of the current public health risk, via email to all attendees no later than one week prior to the start of the event.

What are the vaccine requirements for the Fall Meeting?

In order to register for the Advance CTE Fall Meeting, all attendees and guests must upload an official record of full vaccination for COVID-19 (acceptable forms include photo of CDC Vaccination Card or official state vaccination record). If you have already provided this documentation for a prior Advance CTE event, you do not need to do so again.

If you are unvaccinated due to a religious or medical exemption, you can attend Fall Meeting by providing a negative test result of a PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) taken no more than 72 hours prior to the beginning of the conference on October 17, 2022. The documentation must include the type of test, the healthcare entity that issued the test, the test date, and the name of the person being tested.

Can I receive a refund if I have to cancel my registration?

All cancellations must be submitted by email to meetings@careertech.org. To receive a full refund, a cancellation request must be received by 11:59 p.m. ET on September 20, 2022. Cancellations received between September 21 and September 30, 2022, will be refunded 50% of the registration fee. Cancellations received starting October 1, 2022 will result in no refund. If a registration has been made and the registration fee is not paid prior to the cancellation request, the registrant is still responsible for any applicable unpaid fees.

Meeting no-shows will be responsible for paying the full registration rate. Advance CTE is not responsible for weather-related travel delays, illnesses or other issues in regard to personal travel. No refunds will be given due to these occurrences, once the cancellation window has closed.
