
Builder's Club volunteers meet with students for fun, problem-solving activities to provide exposure to different shipbuilding careers.

Newport News Shipbuilding provides internship opportunities to students and teachers that will transfer classroom knowledge to real life work experiences.




Examples of internship opportunities at NGSB-NN:

Engineering/Technology – Responsibilities and training will involve assisting professional engineers with design and analysis based on current project needs. **Design** - mentored by a professional Designer, the on-the-job training is specifically related to one of the following design engineering disciplines: hull, electrical, machinery, piping, or nuclear using design software such as AutoCAD and/or CATIA **Construction/Trades** – opportunity to learn from an experience craftsman on how to use general tools, measuring devices, read blueprints, and other requirements to become an apprentice or tradesman.

Business – internship will give the student a chance to gain general office skills working in a professional business environment that supports the company in areas such as accounting, payroll, finance, supply chain, planning, human resources, and training

Communications/Arts - multimedia area providing video digitizing, CD and DVD production, video streaming and duplication, audio recording and editing, graphics design, 3-D animation, digital photography, and all types of visual presentation support.

How Business Mentors Can Help Students Maximize their Spring Break Work Experiences

- Inform student intern of arrival time, ending time, checkin, and check-out procedures.
- Let your colleagues know the student will be coming to work. Arrange for someone to greet the student upon his/her arrival.
- Give the student intern a tour of the facility, and introduce the student to all employees with whom he/she will have contact.
- Explain the student's first work assignment and evaluation expectations. (If applicable)
- Inform co-workers of their relationship to student intern, and solicit their cooperation.
- Inform student intern of lunchtime, relief procedures and regulations, as may be applicable to his/her work.
- Inform student intern of facilities such as rest room, lunchroom, telephone, coat rack, etc.
- 8. Inform student intern of time-recording procedure.
- 9. Inform student intern about any information that is to be kept confidential.
- 10. Inform student intern of appropriate work attire.


How Students Can Maximize their Spring Break Work Experiences


- Make sure you know what time you are expected to arrive and depart, and what the check-in and check-out procedures are.
- 2. Introduce yourself with a firm handshake and an audible voice.
- Pay attention during the tour. Don't be embarrassed to take notes about key locations or colleagues with whom you'll be working.
- Don't be afraid to ask questions! Make sure you understand work assignment and how you will be evaluated. (If applicable)
- Make sure you understand when you are expected to take breaks, and what relief procedures and regulations are.
- Locate the important facilities such as the rest room, lunchroom, telephone, coat rack, etc.
- Make sure you understand the time-recording procedure. You need to keep track of your hours for service credit.
- Make sure you maintain the confidentiality of any information you have been told must be kept private.
- Make sure you are aware of the company's dress code. Wear appropriate work attire to the experience.
- 10. Use your Career Readiness Skills... and please remember that you are representing Newport News Public Schools.



- **1.** Increase students' exposure to different Career Pathways

- 4. When businesses are active and visible in the schools, they can see what we are doing well and what we could do better. They can provide feedback about preparing students for careers in a specific field




