## Nevada Career Technical Education (CTE)

### Statistics At-A-Glance:

#### Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$8,609,174<sup>i</sup>
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$8,551,791
- Percent change: -0.67%

#### CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- 9 out of every 10 postsecondary CTE students in Nevada met or exceeded technical skill attainment proficiency levels in 2009-2010.
- Almost all (97%) secondary CTE students in Nevada met or exceeded reading proficiency levels in 2009-2010.
- More than 9 out of every 10 CTE students in Nevada completed high school on time.<sup>ii</sup>
- Almost all secondary (99%) and postsecondary (98%) CTE students in Nevada were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010.<sup>iii</sup>

#### CTE Enrollment Data:

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Nevada in 2009-2010: 57,918<sup>iv</sup>
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Nevada in 2009-2010: 30,163<sup>v</sup>

### CTE: Preparing Nevada's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in NV:

→ *Hospitality and Tourism will be the largest Career Cluster.*

→ *Health Science will be the fastest growing Career Cluster, increasing 46% by 2018.*

→ *In 2018, 51% of all jobs in NV will be found in Hospitality and Tourism, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Business Management and Administration.*

→ *In NV by 2018, there will be about 166,000 jobs for those with certificates.*
