New Jersey Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance:

Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$26,071,027ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$22,509,427
- Percent change: -13.66%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- Almost all (99%) of CTE students in New Jersey completed high school on time.ⁱⁱ
- 94% of secondary CTE students in New Jersey were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010.ⁱⁱⁱ
- Most postsecondary CTE students (97%) met or exceeded technical skill proficiency levels.
- Almost all eligible postsecondary CTE students (99%) attained a certificate, credential, or degree in 2009-2010.

→ *Information Technology will be the fastest growing Career Cluster.*

→ *42% of all jobs in New Jersey will be found in Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism.*

→ *In NJ by 2018, there will be about 425,000 jobs for those with certificates.*
