New York Career Technical Education (CTE)

Statistics At-A-Glance:

CTE Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$66,954,138ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$54,452,906
- Percent change: -18.67%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- In 2009-2010, CTE students in New York graduated from high school at a much higher rate (84%) than the average national rate (71.7%)
- More than 3 out of every 4 CTE students passed the New York State Regents exam, similar to the average rate for students in New Yorkⁱⁱ
- Over 92% of secondary CTE students in New York were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010ⁱⁱⁱ
- The majority (81%) of postsecondary CTE students in New York received a credential, certificate, or degree in 2009-2010^{iv}
- Eighty percent of postsecondary CTE students in New York were employed or placed in military service or apprenticeship programs within six months of leaving postsecondary education in 2009-2010^v

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in New York: 207,348^{vi}
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in New York: 152,487^{vii}

From today through 2018 in NY:

→ Will lead nation in the share of total jobs within state in the Arts, A/V Tech and Communications Career Cluster by 2018

→ Will lead nation in share of total jobs within state in Business, Management and Administration Career Cluster and Education and Training Career Cluster by 2018

→ In New York by 2018, there will be about 880,000 jobs for those with certificates.
