## Ohio Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance:

### Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$49,171,479<sup>i</sup>
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$43,078,218
- Percent change: -12.39%

### CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- CTE students in Ohio graduated from high school at a much higher rate than the statewide rate (99% compared to 84.3%)<sup>ii</sup>
- More than 98.23% of CTE students in Ohio completed high school on time<sup>iii</sup>
- Over 89% of secondary CTE students in Ohio were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010<sup>iv</sup>

### CTE Enrollment Data:

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Ohio: 136,478<sup>v</sup>
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Ohio: 178,081<sup>vi</sup>

### CTE: Preparing Ohio's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in OH:

→ The Business Management and Administration Career Cluster will be the largest overall.

Health Science will be the fastest growing.

→ Health Science will add the most jobs through 2018, while Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources, Arts, A/V Technology, and Communications, Manufacturing, and Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics will lose jobs.

→ 40% of all jobs in Ohio will be found in the Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism Career Clusters.
