## Oklahoma Career Technical Education (CTE) Statistics At-A-Glance:

### Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$16,664,042<sup>i</sup>
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$15,094,180
- Percent change: -9.42%

### CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- Almost all (98%) CTE students in Oklahoma completed high school on time.<sup>ii</sup>
- 9 out of every 10 secondary CTE students in Oklahoma were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010.<sup>iii</sup>
- 94% of eligible adult CTE students earned a postsecondary certificate, credential, or degree in 2009-2010.

### CTE Enrollment Data:

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Oklahoma in 2009-2010: 121,354<sup>iv</sup>
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE in Oklahoma in 2009-2010: 20,383<sup>v</sup>

### CTE: Preparing Oklahoma's Students for Jobs of Today and Jobs of the Future

From today through 2018 in OK:

→ *Business Management and Administration will be the largest Career Cluster in OK.*

→ *Information Technology and Human Services will be the fastest growing Career Clusters, increasing 17% each by 2018.*

→ *Hospitality and Tourism will add the most jobs in Oklahoma through 2018.*

→ *In 2018, 39% of all OK jobs will be found in Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism.*

→ *In OK by 2018, there will be about 196,000 jobs for those with certificates.*
