Statistics At-A-Glance:

Funding:

- Perkins Funds Received in FY10: \$49,131,116ⁱ
- Perkins Funds Received in FY11: \$42,836,625
- Percent change: -12.81%

CTE Student Outcomes Data:

- CTE students in Pennsylvania graduated from high school at a higher rate than the statewide rate in 2009-2010 (98% compared to 90%)ⁱⁱ
- The majority of secondary (88%) and postsecondary (88%) CTE students in Pennsylvania were employed, in the military, or in postsecondary education or advanced training six months after graduation in 2009-2010ⁱⁱⁱ
- Almost all (98%) of secondary CTE students in Pennsylvania graduated high school on time^{iv}

- Number of Secondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 91,543^v
- Number of Postsecondary Students Enrolled in CTE: 76,553^{vi}

From today through 2018 in PA:

- ➔ *The Marketing, Sales, and Services Career Cluster will be the largest in PA.*
- ➔ *Health Science will be the fastest growing, with jobs increasing by 17% by 2018.*
- ➔ *40% of all jobs in PA will be found in the Business Management and Administration, Marketing, Sales, and Services, and Hospitality and Tourism Career Clusters.*
- ➔ *In PA by 2018, there will be about 630,000 jobs for those with certificates.*
