Connections - External

- First interactions with industry and/or K-12 educational institutions

 - Look for grant funding

- Identify curriculum gaps between dual credit, San Jacinto College and university transfers.

BUY-IN

- Forums
 - Exploratory
- Councils
 - Lead by the Chancellor and Industry Chair
 - C-Level industry representation
 - Education partners included as listeners
 - Committee members as observers
- Committees
 - Led by Industry Chair
 - Industry HR, Training Coordinators
 - College staff and educational partners included as listeners



LIVING and LEARNING

- Externships
 - Provide faculty with up-to-date industry experience
 - Paid, 1-3 weeks, during the summer
- Internships
 - Provides students opportunities for experience
 - Long –term interview
- Apprenticeships
 - Industry, student, educational organization
 - Crosswalks



LIVING and LEARNING

- Pre-apprenticeships
 - Dual Credit and Registered Apprenticeship
 - K- 12 Workbased Learning Opportunities
- Data collection LightCast
 - Designated Analyst
- Competition
 - Learn from what others are doing enrollment forms, marketing, etc.
 - Don't be afraid of transparency both internal and external
 - Find a champion
